As we do not provide bus transportation to the Camps for 12-Day Session campers, these campers must be brought directly to the Canoe Lake Portage Store on July 18th or August 15th, 2010.

Wapomeo: Girls should be brought to the Canoe Lake Portage Store off Highway 60 (east from Huntsville or west from Ottawa). Take the Canoe Lake Portage Store exit. A barge will be available at the public transportation dock, at **2:30 pm** to transport campers to Camp Wapomeo. Staff will be available to assist with the luggage. **Please note: Lifejacket(s) are required for the campers.**

Ahmek: Boys should be brought to the Canoe Lake Portage Store off Highway 60 (east from Huntsville or west from Ottawa). Take the Canoe Lake Portage Store exit. A bus will be available in the upper parking lot (first parking lot on the right) at **2:30 pm** to transport campers to Camp Ahmek. Staff will be available to assist with the luggage.
