Part of your **contractual obligation** to the Taylor Statten Camps is your **participation and completion** of the **Ministry of Labor's Worker Health and Safety Awareness Training**. This training introduces employees to the Occupational Health and Safety Act and outlines the health and safety rights and responsibilities of supervisors, employers, and employees (workers). Note that it also acts as a general introduction to workplace health and safety.

The training program can be completed by either filling out or submitting the workbook, or by using the eLearning module. (You have to watch each video from beginning to end or else you will not be allowed to progress to the next segment).

I recommend you use the eLearning module as it is easy and quick to complete. Once you have completed the training you will be given a Proof of Completion certificate.
